We Will Rock You!

Our overarching theme for this term is 'We Will Rock You!'. This theme focuses on the historical period of the Stone Age. Throughout the term, we will be travelling back in time to discover what life was like thousands of years ago. During History and Geography lessons, we will be learning about Stone Age people, houses, food, survival and much more. Additionally, we will draw comparisons between the Stone Age and Bronze Age time frames, acknowledging how the lifestyles of people has changed and adapted throughout history. We will also be looking at some of the fascinating prehistoric creatures that lived in the Stone Age era

English

The Stone Age will be our central focus for many of our English lessons within the Spring Term, and we will be using a number of texts and film extracts to support this, including 'Stone Age Boy'. We will be studying in detail instructional writing, narratives and recounts. We will be exploring a number of descriptive techniques including figurative language, as well as continuing to expand our knowledge of subject specific vocabulary.

Science

This term, children will be learning about the following two topics: Forces and Magnets

- Comparing how different objects move on a variety of surfaces.
- Observing how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others.

- Understanding and explain how soil and fossils are formed.
- Identifying the three different types of skeleton and explain the importance of the muscular system.
