



## Maths

In Year 4 during the summer term, the White Rose Maths curriculum focuses on helping children consolidate key skills and deepen their understanding of core mathematical concepts. Pupils will explore topics such as money, time, statistics, geometry (including properties of shape and position and direction), and begin to apply their knowledge to more complex problem-solving. They'll also continue to strengthen their understanding of times tables up to  $12 \times 12$ , which supports mental arithmetic and prepares them for the Year 4 multiplication check. These lessons aim to build confidence, encourage logical thinking, and show how maths connects to everyday life.

In English this summer term, we will be developing key writing skills such as structuring ideas into clear paragraphs, using fronted adverbials to vary sentence openings, and ex-
