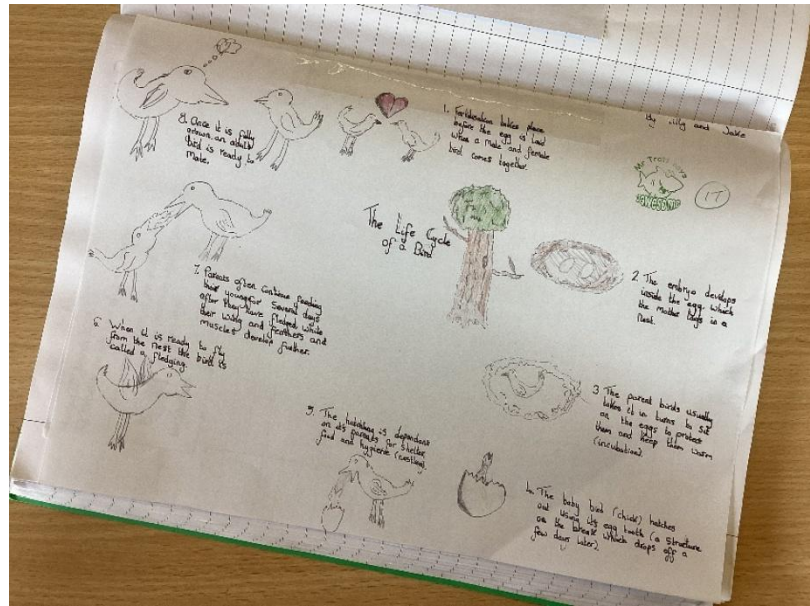


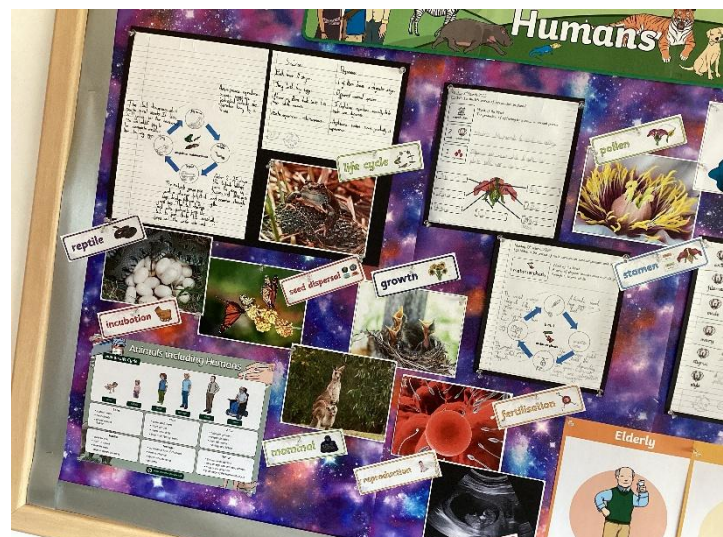
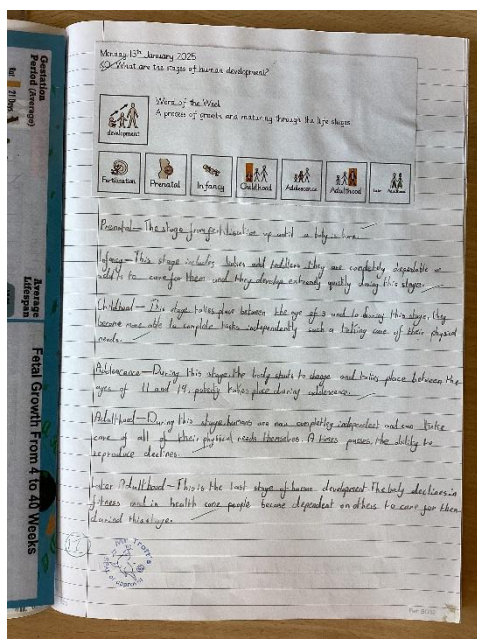
Science Curriculum Update – Year 5

Over the last term, Year 5 have studied the biology of both humans and living things across the globe, first delving into the life stages of a human as part of our Animals Including Humans unit. Here,



pupils gained greater knowledge of the infancy stage and how babies develop into young children, before the stages of adolescence (and grumpiness), adulthood and later adulthood impact our bodies and physicality with age. Children also drew comparisons regarding gestation periods, principally between humans and then other mammals, such as mice and elephants.

Transitioning to our Living Things and their Habitats module, students discovered the secret life of plants and how reproduction varies according to the species, before exploring the life cycles of birds,



mammals and the fascinating process of metamorphosis that encapsulates some of our most weird and wonderful creatures.
