Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome back to the final half-term of this school year as we look forward to the many events ahead with transition in mind in the coming weeks whilst also affording ourselves the opportunity to look back on what has been yet another outstanding year at our school where, collectively and individually, we have achieved so much.

With the exciting learning and events ahead of us, please continue to make sure your child is an 'Attendance HERO' (Here, Everyday, Ready and On-time). Our hope and ambition are for every child to attain a minimum attendance rate of at least **96%** for the term and over the school year. I never want any child to miss the fun, happy memories and educational entitlement they deserve at Oak Meadow knowing how working together, we can realise the absolute best achievements for them.
