Learning about self respect and respect of others. We will also learn about the life of Moses in RE.

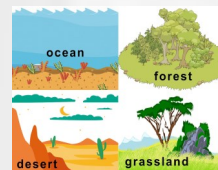
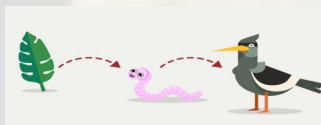
Mathematics

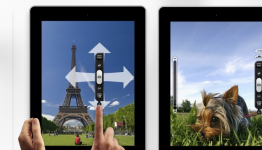
