We cast votes!

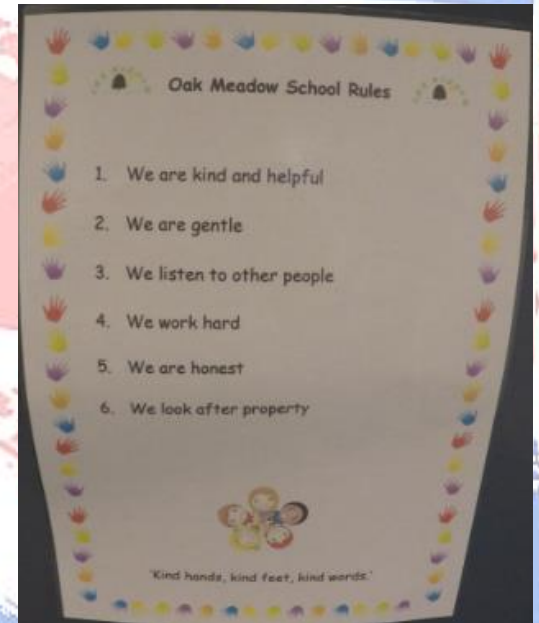


Rule of Law
