What is Forest School?

'An innovative learning approach to outdoor play and learning'

By regularly attending Forest School sessions, children, develop positive self-esteem, increase their personal awareness and awareness of those around them, building social and emotional skills. They have opportunities to improve their problem solving, communication skills, and more importantly have fun in the natural environment.

We will be playing with mud, building shelters, looking for minibeasts, learning about trees, the weather and habitats. We will be jumping, climbing, balancing, creeping, talking quietly and shouting loudly, measuring, and creating.

Where?

Currently we be using the school grounds but as we develop forest school we will be using Kingswood and other local woodland venues.

Who?

We will run forest school one day a week. All children will have the opportunity to attend Forest School.
