Dear Parents/ Carers,

Reflecting on last term, I would like to express my continued gratitude for your support and the partnership that we have built to provide the very best education for the children. I know how hard all staff work to innovate, create and implement outstanding learning opportunities and the positive validation you gave in our recent Parent Survey re-affirmed our positive relationships – the cornerstone of all success at our school.

To give examples of the outcomes from the survey, 100% of parents and carers agreed that our school nurtures children's creativity and that the school has high expectations for children and encourages them to be the best that they can be. As pupil places at Oak Meadow remain in high demand it is clear to see why as 99% of parents and carers stated they would recommend Oak Meadow to another parent. As a parent myself, I know the pivotal role school plays in family life and how important it is to know your child is safe, nurtured and happy every day. Finally, with uniform requirements in mind, and in response to conversations I have had with children, parents, carers and staff, from tomorrow (Tuesday 9th April) and for the summer term children will be able to wear their PE kit for the entire day they have their PE lesson. If you are unsure of these days, please confirm them with your child's class teacher but my hope is that this will maximise learning time, help in staying cool in the hotter weather and support your preparations at home. Please remember that on their PE days, children must be dressed in our school PE kit. As ever, this is a plain white T-shirt and black shorts with white or black (inexpensive) trainers. If wearing tracksuits, again we ask for simple bottoms and tops (with darker colours preferred) with any expensive, designer brands strongly discouraged given the pursuits children may be asked to complete. Football tops are not permitted for the school day, however if your child attends an after-school club they may bring different sportswear to change into before the club begins.
