**Kingswood Residential Visit – Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> – Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022**

Given the restrictions of the last two years and the safety measures and guidelines we have upheld, I am extremely pleased to write to inform you that we have booked our traditional annual Year 2 residential visit to Kingswood Trust.

The Kingswood Trust specialises in outdoor learning, maximising learning opportunities through nature. The centre is approximately 35 minutes' drive and its outdoor programmes promote children's health and wellbeing whilst developing further children's sense of curiosity and fascination in the natural world.

The Kingswood originally began as a holiday camp in 1923 to promote holidays for 'poor' children and still today has buildings originating from this period along with air raid shelters, historical features and artefacts. Our planned visit however, will focus upon providing children with outdoor learning experiences in the site's nine acres of land including looking at plant and animal natural habitats, pond areas, bird hides, climbing of trees, adventure ropes, forest school base camp activities and opportunities to meet the residential sheep, ducks, chickens, rabbits, guinea pigs and tortoises. The children will be supported in their learning by both The Kingswood's staffing and Oak Meadow staff. Historically, the children return from the visit with tremendous memories of their overnight stay and learning experiences and it is often number 1 on Year 6's memories when recalling their highlights of their Oak Meadow days for their leaving performance. We do hope as many children as possible can access the visit. The cost of the visit will be £77.00 and £62.00 if your child is in receipt of income-based free school meals. To support with the costs of this visit, transport costs to and from The Kingswood will be funded by our School Fund.

To support the payment of the visit, we ask for an initial deposit of £20 (payable by Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> November) and the remaining balance to be paid by instalment as outlined below, via ParentPay:

**A place will not be reserved if the deposit is not received by the due date as The Kingswood will only reserve for the number of children we pay for.**

Consent is given and payments are to be made via ParentPay.
