Full Reopening of Schools: September 2020

As a staff, whilst looking forward to the summer holidays where school will be fully closed, we look forward to the new school year and to welcoming our new prospective Reception children and parents and all our other children and families to the new school year.

Whilst we remain living with the COVID-19 pandemic, the Government continues to guide us in all operational procedures, which encompasses arrangements for September time.

School Dinners for Key Stage 2 pupils.

School meals cost will increase to £2.30 per day, £11.50 per week. As stipulated by our catering providers, school dinners must be paid for in advance of the week. It is possible to opt for school meals on certain days of the week but we would ask you to let us know on Mondays which days your child is staying and make payments accordingly. Payment should be made via ParentPay only.

I write wistfully thinking about our 2020 Year 6 Leavers and the celebrations we have been unable to lead given COVID-19. Year 6 staff, including Miss Challenor and I, met with most of our Year 6 parents, carers and children on Monday and shared with them commemorative videos, gifts and our very best wishes for their move to secondary school.
