In anticipation of the change in our school uniform, from summer to winter one, I write to remind you of our expectations and where it can be purchased from.

Girls' Uniform: Apple Green shirt / blouse to be worn with a tie a grey skirt/pinafore or tailored trouser (Black is not permitted) brown v-neck cardigan and suitable black shoes for the weather.

Boys' Uniform: Grey trousers with an apple green cotton shirt and tie and a brown v-neck sweatshirt.

Apple green shirts can be purchased from the following suppliers only:
Clemmy's Schoolwear – Darlaston
Kids Corner – Showell Circus
Trutex – Wolverhampton Town Centre
Uniform Stall on both Walsall and Willenhall markets.

Following the half term break, the emerald polo shirts cannot be worn.

Both boys and girls can continue to wear their brown Oak Meadow jumpers or cardigans. We do ask that sensible black shoes are worn with girls wearing plain socks and boys wearing plain grey socks. Training shoes are not allowed as part of our uniform including training shoes with stripes or brand emblem.

Can I also respectfully remind you that all long / shoulder length hair should be tied back and no nail varnish or jewellery is worn in school. Thank you.
